### **Homework**

All children have been given updated home learning codes for the Seesaw CLASS app. Please help them to get this set up on their device and remind them to check each week. We will be sending home CGP Maths practice books for Maths homework each Friday. These should be returned on Tuesday each week so we can mark them together in class. Occasionally other homework, such as reading comprehension or GPS may be assigned via Seesaw.

### **Reading**

Children should be reading at home each day for a minimum of twenty minutes. The expectation is that children will read and quiz on at least one Accelerated Reader book each month. Please listen to your child read out loud at least once a week and sign the reading record. If your child still struggles with fluency, increase this as much as is possible as this will support them greatly and make a difference.

### **Spelling**

The children will be assigned Spelling Shed games to complete each week. The assigned games are based on the children's weekly spellings. The children are expected to complete at least five games each week. There will be a spelling test based on these words every Friday.

### **Times Tables Rockstars**

The children will be set garage sessions to complete on TT Rockstars each week. The sessions are refreshed every Friday and I will be checking to see who is completing them.

### **Reminders**

PE PE lessons will take place twice a week; on Mondays and Fridays. Year 6 are the first class to have swimming lessons and they will take place on Mondays this year. We will have six lessons. They will commence on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> September and run until Monday 20<sup>th</sup> October.













### **Water bottles and snacks**

Your child will need a named water bottle in school each day. Children may have a snack or a piece of fruit/vegetable during their breaktime. In Year 6 children also have a pencil case privilege where they are allowed to bring in their own.

# Year 6 - Autumn Curriculum 2025

<p><b>English</b> We will be reading two class novels this term: 'Letters from the Lighthouse' and, 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe'. We will be focussing on accuracy and coherence of written language.</p> 	<p><b>Maths</b> We will further develop place value skills and ensure arithmetic is accurate and efficient. We will learn long division and long multiplication. The children will also be developing their understanding of fractions and looking at position and direction.</p> 	<p><b>Science</b> In Biology, we will learn about living things and their habitats. We will then move onto Physics, where we will learn about electrical components and make our own circuits.</p> 	<p><b>RE</b> We will focus on two key questions this term; 'How do beliefs and ideas about land shape the way human beings live?' and, 'Creation and science, is it conflicting or complimentary?'</p> 	
<p><b>Computing</b> The children will produce a symphony of shapes on Scratch, create music on Microbits, use cameras, photos, One Stop Studio, iMovie and Garage Band, learn to programme using Python and create and innovate on Scratch.</p> 	<p><b>History Autumn 1</b> <i>'What was the impact of World War 2 on the people of Britain?'</i> We will look at the Second World War and how it impacted people in Britain.</p> 	<p><b>Geography Autumn 2</b> <i>'Where does our energy come from?'</i> We will look at where energy comes from. We will learn about renewable and non-renewable energy sources.</p> 	<p><b>PE</b> In the first half-term we will develop stamina and strokes in swimming and develop our ideas into choreography in dance. In the second half-term we will learn key skills in dodgeball such as throwing and catching; and defending and attacking skills in hockey.</p> 	
<p><b>French</b> This term we will learn about school life in France; similarities and differences, school subjects, places and will be introduced to our Penpals!</p> 	<p><b>Art</b> In Art we will using digital media to design and create photographic imagery for a design brief.</p> 	<p><b>DT</b> In DT we will develop a steady hand game using a series circuit, including housing and blackboard.</p> 	<p><b>Music</b> This term we will study the song 'Happy', find the pulse and recognise instruments. We will also play, improvise and compose our own jazz.</p> 	<p><b>PSHE</b> Our topics are based on Protective Behaviours, Zones of Regulation, families and relationships and health and wellbeing.</p>
