If any person in that bubble shows symptoms, they will be sent home and asked to book a test as soon as possible.  All staff and pupils will have access to testing if they develop symptoms of the coronavirus. If the test returns positive, the affected pupil or member of staff will be required to self-isolate at home for 7 days, and any pupils and members of staff they have been in close contact with (i.e. the rest of the child or adult's 'bubble') will have to isolate for 14 days at home. If the test is negative, the child or adult will be able to return to school once they feel well. This action will help
