Remote Learning

What will learning look like during this period?

The children will be assigned 3 activities per day on Seesaw to complete. These activities will usually involve some form of pre-recorded lesson or clear instruction on how to self-guide the learning. Please encourage your child to complete the activities to the best of their ability and with the same high standards which we expect in the classroom.

Reading

Please encourage your child to continue to read at least 5 times per week and listen to them read at least once a week. If your child still struggles with fluency, increase this as much as is possible as this will support them greatly and make a difference. Many books which you may already have at home will be on the AR system. You can check by going to www.arbookfind.co.uk. Spelling

Spellings will continue to be set each Monday and will be tested on Fridays. Please encourage your child to practise these each day.

Times Tables Rockstars

I will set a weekly task on TTRockstars, usually on a Friday, as well as our usual weekly timed challenge. Your child knows how to login and should be able to do this independently. This is a minimum expectation, and I would encourage daily short bursts of practise for anyone not yet secure with their times tables.

<u>PE</u>

Simon from Fit4Kids will be recording a PE lesson for the class each week. This will become one of the day's three activities on a Wednesday. Please encourage your child to participate and remind them to wear appropriate clothing and have a water bottle to hand.
