Homework

The children will be assigned up to 3 activities per week on Seesaw to complete at home. These activities will usually involve a maths task, spelling assignment and sometimes another task related to our topic.

Reading

Please encourage your child to continue to read at least 5 times per week and listen to them read at least once a week. If your child still struggles with fluency, increase this as much as is possible as this will support them greatly and make a difference. Spelling

Spellings will continue to be set each Friday and will be tested on the following Friday. Please encourage your child to practise these each day.

Times Tables Rockstars

I will set a weekly task on TTRockstars, usually on a Friday, as well as our usual weekly timed challenge. Your child knows how to log in and should be able to do this independently. This is a minimum expectation and I would encourage daily short bursts of practise for anyone not yet secure with their times tables.

Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school every day, along with plenty of water. 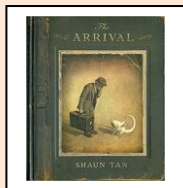
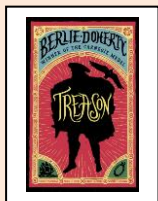
Learning Information

English

Our class texts will be 'Treason' by Berlie Doherty and 'The Arrival' by Sean Tan. From these, the children will produce a wide range of writing to include narratives, non-fiction and poetry.



Maths

This term, we will be deepening our understanding of decimals and percentages. We will then move on to geometry (angles) and measurement of length, time and capacity, with plenty of opportunity to apply these skills across the curriculum.



Science

Our topic this term is Animals Including Humans. We will look at the changes humans, and other animals, go through as we progress to old age. We will learn to interpret and present scientific data in graph, oral and written form.



Computing

This term, we will look into how search engines work and how to search more effectively when using them. In addition, we will programme Lego WeDo to achieve specific aims.



History

The children will find out all about life during the Tudor Period, by using a combination of primary and secondary sources. They will investigate, among other things: Why did Henry break with Rome? How were people punished for breaking the law? Why were the Tudors so keen on exploration?

Geography
